The Event will be a Victorian State Championship Circuit Race Event, conducted at the Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit in an anticlockwise direction from the 25<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> September 2021, held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia, [the](#) Circuit Race Standing Regulations, the 2021 Motorsport Australia Victorian State Circuit Racing Championship Series Regulations, the Phillip Island Standing Race Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or instructions issued.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Motorsport Australia Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).

### EVENT DESCRIPTION

The Event will be a **State Championship Circuit Race Event** held over two days. The activities will be conducted at Phillip Island and cars will circulate in an anticlockwise direction.

### ENTRIES

**The preferred method of entry is via Motorsport Australia Event Entry** – Go to [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au), sign in then follow link to Motorsport Australia Event Entry. Those using it know it is easy and efficient. We strongly encourage you to use this time saving system. There is a tutorial on the website for first timers and a telephone help number for use during business hours.

Entries will open on publication of these Regulations and close on 21st September 2021.

Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR's of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

The Entry Fee will be **\$495.00 (GST Inc)**

A surcharge of \$110 including GST applies to any entry which nominates for more than one category with the same Driver. In these cases the Driver must indicate on the Entry Form his/hers first and second choice of which category they would like to run. A separate full Entry Fee is payable if the cross entry is for the same vehicle but with a different Driver. A separate full Entry Fee is also payable if a Driver enters more than one category with a different vehicle. Individual entries must be completed by each car and Driver.

Vehicle classes and eligibility can be found in the *2021 Victorian State Circuit Racing Championships Series Regulations* at [www.vicstateraceseries.com](http://www.vicstateraceseries.com)

All Drivers must be current financial member of a Motorsport Australia affiliated club and hold a minimum of a Motorsport Australia Circuit Licence with provisional endorsement.

Competition Numbers will be allocated at the Promoters discretion, where possible according to the categories allocated numbers which have been supplied to the series by the Category Representatives. Numbers will otherwise be allocated to best fit with category allocations and Competitors wishes as much as is possible. Only two figure number will be permitted.

## **GARAGE HIRE**

**Garages may be hired via Motorsport Event Entry.**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au)

Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR's of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

The Promoter reserves the right to cancel, postpone or abandon the Event in accordance with the NCR's.

Timing will be electronic and each Competitor will require a Dorian Transmitter, fitted in accordance with category provisions and in the left or right foot well of sedan based vehicles.

### **ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES**

The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au). Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).

### **INVITED CATEGORIES**

Formula Ford 1600 & Formula Ford, Formula Vee, Improved Production Cars, Sports Cars– as listed in Appendix A of the 2021 VSCRC Regulations, Porsche 944 Challenge, Saloon Cars, Circuit Excels, Sports Sedans, HQ Holdens, BMW E30, Historic Touring Cars.

### **FUEL REQUIREMENTS**

Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

### **NOISE**

Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with the 95 dB noise limit.

### **TARGETED SCRUTINY**

Targeted Scrutiny and Return To Race Self Scrutiny procedures will apply. **PLEASE NOTE. A photocopy or scan of the vehicle log book showing the last audit and the Events since is required to be submitted via Email to [vscrcfive@gmail.com](mailto:vscrcfive@gmail.com)**

Vehicle Logbooks will be checked by Scrutineers to confirm which vehicles are due for audit; and if required, suitable arrangements will be made. Please note that this does not mean your car will not be subject to Scrutiny throughout the weekend. Drivers will be required to present upon request their current Motorsport licence, Motorsport Australia affiliated car club membership, and vehicle logbook.

All Driver apparel shall comply with Schedule D of the 2021 Motorsport Australia Manual and is also subject to Targeted Scrutiny.
